2025 Sandusky County High School Football Preview

FREMONT ROSS: Chad Long is starting season 10 as head coach of the Little Giants. In 2024, the team posted a 5-6 overall record, but were 3-1 inside the Northern Lakes League Cardinal Division, good for second place. Ross qualified for the Division II playoffs, but lost to Medina Highland in the first round. In addition to their NLL opponents this season, the Little Giants play Tiffin Columbian, Sandusky and Toledo Scott.

ST. JOE CENTRAL CATHOLIC: In 2025, the Crimson Streaks will again play an 8-man football schedule, with head coach Josh Wehring leading the way. SJCC improved from 0-9 in the 2023 season to 3-6 in 2024, their first year in the Northern 8 Conference. The *Please turn to page 5.*





Fliers complete a 8-4 overall record last year, including 2-2 in SBC Lake Division play. They qualified for the Division IV playoffs, defeating Otsego in the first round but losing to Ontario in the second round. Non-SBC games this year include Toledo Start, Ashland and Toledo St. Francis.

BELLEVUE: For the first time in over 30 years, the Bellevue Redmen will have a new head football coach. Alex Shepherd takes over for the legendary Ed Nasonti. who retired after the 2024 season. The Redmen look to rebound from last year's 2-8 overall record. In addition to Sandusky Bay Conference opponents, Bellevue will take on Wauseon and Shelby.

LAKOTA: Ryan Lozier will begin season two as the head coach of the Lakota Raiders. Last season, the squad finished 2-8 overall record, with one win inside the SBC River Division. In addition to Sandusky Bay Conference foes, the Raiders will take on Elmwood, Arcadia, and Toledo Christian in non-conference play.

WOODMORE: Scott Stecher starts his second season as head football coach at Woodmore. In 2024, the Wildcats improved to a 5-6 overall record, including 2-4 inside the Sandusky Bay Conference River Division. Their 2025 non-conference schedule includes North Central, Montpelier and Fostoria.





Centerburg Looks to Build on 8-4 Season Behind Andy Collela

The Centerburg Trojans football team finished 8-4 last season but they have several key pieces back to try and make a run at a KMAC crown in 2025. 
